

GROUPS OF 2-3

The Bible says whenever 2-3 are gathered in the name of Jesus, He Himself is there with them. That's an amazing promise! As we seek God together, we invite more of His Presence into our lives and into the places we gather. This is both an invitation and a calling. God wants to transform our lives and use our lives to bring transformation to others. This is the purpose of His Church!

THERE'S LOTS OF WAYS TO GATHER WITH A FEW OTHERS IN THE NAME OF JESUS! HERE ARE SOME IDEAS:

- 1** Ask 1-2 friends who love God to meet with you regularly for prayer, encouragement, accountability and to seek God together!
- 2** Determine if there are any other believers where you currently do life (work, school, neighborhood, activities) and see if they'd be interested in gathering to encourage one another and pray for that place!
- 3** Seek out someone who has been following Jesus a little longer than you who can encourage you and model what it means to be a mature disciple of Jesus.
- 4** Think of someone who wants to learn more about God or grow in their relationship with Him and offer to meet with them regularly to read the Bible and pray.

SOME THINGS YOU CAN DO WHEN YOU GATHER:

- Check in on how each person is doing
- Encourage one another
- Hold each other accountable
- Share testimonies
- Worship together
- Pray for one another
- Pray for the people and places you are believing for God to bring transformation
- Pray for our city, nation and world
- Read the Bible
- Commit to obeying what God is calling you to do
- Find ways to serve others together

CONNECT (15-20 MIN)

Here are some questions you can ask each other! Pick 1-2 each time you meet.

1. What has connecting with God looked like for you this week? What is God teaching you?
2. Is there anything you need to repent of or bring into the light?
3. Who are you praying for and reaching out to? Any testimonies to share?
4. How can I pray for you? Pray right then for any needs that surface!

Tip: Look at the clock before you begin talking & stick to sharing for a reasonable amount of time (usually 5-7 minutes per person is good). The goal of the group isn't simply to process life so you'll have to manage your time and yourself to leave space for the other elements of the group!

CONTENT (15-20 MIN)

Download "The Discipleship App" -- the main resource we recommend for your group! It is an awesome starting point and ensures everyone in your group has a firm, Biblical foundation for their faith. Start with "New To Faith" (even if you're not) then work through the different Kingdom Values.

You'll be reading a passage of Scripture together then answering these questions:

What is the main point?

What does this teach me about God?

What does this teach me about people or myself?

How can I apply this to my life?

Once you finish the content provided in the App, you can simply choose a passage of Scripture based on a topic your group is interested in and use this same flow!

COMMIT (15-20 MIN)

- How did it go doing what you committed to last time we met?
- What will obeying God and His Word look like for you this week?
- How will we live on mission together this week? What places and spaces are we believing for God's Kingdom to be established?

End by praying for the grace of God to empower you guys to do what He's called you to do. Pray for the people you are reaching out to.
